 The mission of the library media program is to ensure that students and staff are effective users of ideas and information. This mission is accomplished:


 by providing intellectual and physical access to materials in all formats








- U -- Ugly -- usually refers to the book's physical condition.
- S -- Superseded -- usually means there are newer copies available.
- T -- Trivial -- Appropriateness for the collection.
- Y -- Your collection has no use / room for the book.

The goal of this initiative is to provide guidance to school library media specialists in the development of best practices for teaching and learning. The resource documents identify skills that students need in order to be successful in meeting the Virginia Standards of Learning. It also provides strategies and activities that integrate technology into the curriculum and fosters the development of literacy skills that will enable students to become discriminating and efficient users of information.
